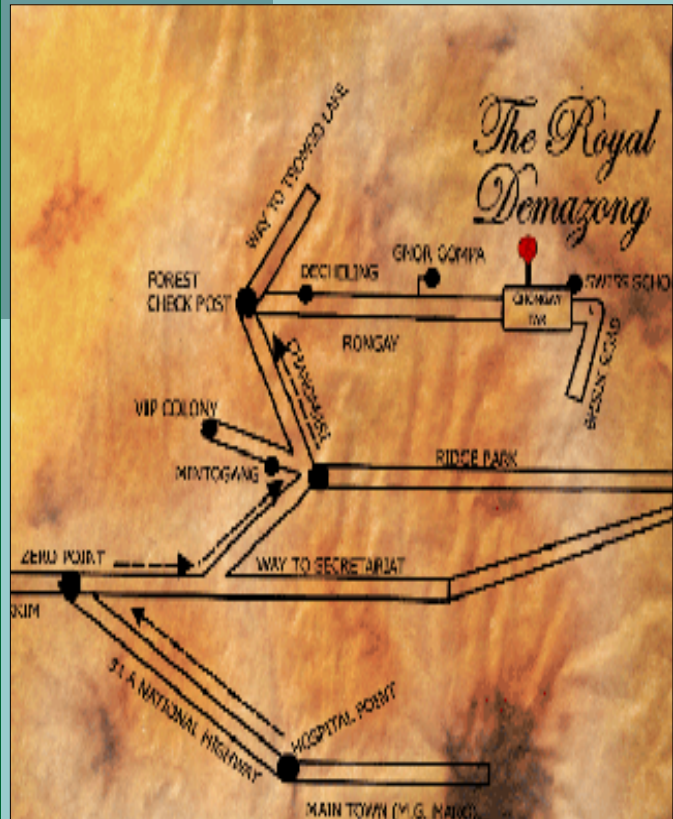

East District on Heaven's Trail - GANGTOK

Gangtok means the top of a hill. The capital of Sikkim, it is at an elevation of 5,600 feet (1,700 m), and built on the flank of a ridge. With a resident population of 30,000 people, it is the largest town in Sikkim. In recent times it has developed somewhat haphazardly and can get quite congested during the peak summer season and in Oct, during the Dussehra holidays. At other times, and away from the main hub of town, there are delightful walks with great natural scenery and some excellent views of Mt. Khangchendzonga. The town's ambience derives from a blend of tradition and modernity. There is a sense of calm and serenity, symbolized by the stupas and monasteries in Gangtok.

How to get there

Located between Gangtok town and Tsomgo Lake, Club Mahindra Royal Demazong (dey-muh-jong) is only 30mins (6kms) minutes drive from Gangtok town.

Air: The nearest airport is Bagdogra in North Bengal which is 124 kms and approximately 5 hrs. drive from Gangtok. Bagdora has regular Airline Services from Calcutta and Delhi and also within the North East.

Rail: The two closest railway stations are Siliguri (114 kms.) and New Jalpaiguri (125 kms) connecting Calcutta, Delhi, Guwahati, Lucknow and other important cities in India.

Road: Gangtok is connected by road with Darjeeling, Kalimpong, Siliguri and other centres and also with all the district headquarters within Sikkim. The Sikkim Nationalised Transport plies regular bus services linking these places.

The Transport wing of the Department of Tourism, Government of Sikkim has a number of cars, luxury coaches & jeeps for hire.

Private taxis are available at Bagdogra for Gangtok and also for Siliguri. All taxis in Gangtok are provided with fixed rate charts.

What are the places of interest?

Deer Park

The Red Panda and fleet footed deer can be observed in a natural habitat. An imposing statue of the Buddha is situated here. (Open from 8.00 am- 11 am. on working days and 8.00 am. to 5.00 pm. on holidays).



Research Institute of Tibetology

Renowned worldwide centre for study of Buddhist philosophy and religion, it is a treasure house of rare thankas, statues, over 200 Buddhist icons and prized objects of art. (Closed on Second Saturdays and Govt. holidays).



Ganesh Tok

About 7 kms from the city it offers majestic views of the city far below and the looming Mt Khangchendzonga and Mt Siniolchu.



Nathula

Nathu La is a pass on the Indo-Chinese border that serves as a trade link between the two countries. Situated at a distance of 56 kms from Gangtok, Nathu La once had been the main access for Sikkim -Tibet Trade. Nathu La used to be known as the Silk Route. At an elevation of 14,450 feet, Nathu La is renowned for its diverse alpine flora and fauna. The terms 'Nathu' and 'La' literally mean 'listening ears' and 'pass' respectively in Tibetan language.

The road to Nathu La is one of the highest motorable roads in India. This road passes through Tsomgo Lake on its way to Nathu La Pass. For the most of the part of the year, this tranquil place remains covered under a thick layer of snow. A special permit is required in order to visit Nathu La Pass.



Himalayan Zoological Park

Located 8 km away from town it is home to the elusive red panda, the cuddly state animal, barking deer, Himalayan black bear and others.

Pal Zurmang Kagyud Monastery

Located at Lingdum village about 20 Km from Gangtok it was built by the present Gharwang Rinpoche who is the 12th incarnate of Zurmang Gharwang.
